Tree Root Barrier

- Tree Root Barrier By Green Blue Urban (or similar) to be used to protect existing and proposed services and hard-standing and building foundations. Location and depth of product be continually reviewed and developed up to and during construction phase with engineering and M&E design. Depth of barrier to suit depth of construction, service or foundation.
